WHO

Pasadena Showcase House for the Arts (PSHA), a non-profit organization bringing music enrichment programs to Southern California.

WHAT

Pasadena Showcase House for the Arts' annual fundraiser, the Pasadena Showcase House of Design, is one of the oldest, largest and most successful house and garden tours in the country. Now in its 56th year, the Showcase House is visited by approximately 25,000 guests annually.

April 26 to May 17, 2020

WHERE

Arcadia, CA

As a courtesy to our neighbors, no parking is allowed in the neighborhood at the Pasadena Showcase House of Design, and neither is drop-off/pick-up. OVERVIEW

The 56th Pasadena Showcase House of Design will be held at the Locke House, situated on park-like grounds in the historic Santa Anita Oaks neighborhood of Arcadia. House tours are from April 26 through May 17, 2020 (house tours are closed on Mondays). The Federal-country style, 6,700 square-foot home was designed by Gerard R. Colcord, known as “Hollywood’s society architect.” It will be reimaged by 17 interior designers and 4 exterior designers. Shops at Showcase will feature approximately 26 vendors. The Restaurant at Showcase and the Pub at Showcase are onsite for drinks and dining. Daily afternoon entertainment in the Pub and on the backyard stage will add to the festivities. Tickets will also be available for special Saturday evening concerts. Proceeds from this annual fundraiser benefit arts and music programs throughout Southern California.

There are no house tours on Mondays.

THE LOCKE HOUSE The Locke House is a 1937 Federal-country estate designed by “Hollywood’s society architect,” Gerard R. Colcord. The house is nestled among mature oaks and sits on expansive, park-like grounds in the historic Santa Anita Oaks neighborhood of Arcadia. The house is virtually unchanged from its original design and features refined Federal detailing throughout the trim, windows, fireplaces and hardware. It includes classical design elements such as painted brick, wood shingles, elongated windows, and a front door crowned by a Georgian-style broken pediment. The two-story home is approximately 6,700 square-feet.
